1. Overall Increase in Efficiency

2. Single Operator

Since grapple trucks are operated by a single operator, reduction in crew allows for redistribution of labor to most efficient use.

3. Cost Savings

Reduction in manpower, fuel and maintenance costs of unnecessary additional equipment, Workman's Compensation claims.

4. Reduce Unnecessary Equipment

Adding a grapple truck to the fleet can eliminate the need for back hoes, chippers, dump trucks, trailers and more.

5. Wide Range of Use
